

LI Zoom Class on Accordion+Music+Culture for Adults 50+ Submitted by Pamela Tom

avid Noferi (Los Angeles Accordionaires President) will give an 8- week Internet accordion lecture series via Zoom on Thursdays (July 8 – August 26, 20201 from 1:30 – 3:00 PM) for player or curious students aged 50+. The program is sponsored by the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) at California State University, Long Beach (CSULB). The course is \$15 plus semi-annual membership fee of \$20. Scholarships are available for people with financial need which results in students paying 10%. Sign-up starts June 14, 2021 at 9 AM. This course is an overview of the accordion and how it is embraced in cultures throughout the globe. Whether you are a student of history or different cultures or simply curious about the instrument, you will find many points of interest across many genres of music. Classes consist of story-telling (sometimes humorous) supported by music videos to provide audio-visual examples. Open discussion is encouraged. Class limit: 12.
